### **Thematic main chapters**

The complete articles consist of a main text and a comment. Every main text of a German author will be commented by an international expert, and vice versa.

### **Key question for the contents of the comments**

Which role do the topic and the deliberations of the main text play in the context of research and/or economy in your country?

### **Formatting specifications for the comments**

- Side margins: Top 4 cm, bottom 2,5 cm, left 2 cm, right 5 cm
- Font: Times New Roman, size 12
- Line spacing: 1,5; hyphenless justification
- Accentuations: Bold – no cursive accentuations
- Captions: Size 12 bold
- Literature index: At the end of the article
- Citations: American, “Harvard-System”
